Dear Artist,

You are invited to participate in the Lemon Street Gallery art-making, fund-raising event, **CAGED! Artists in Their Natural Habitat 2010**.

This great ART day will be held on SATURDAY, JULY 10th, 2010 from 10am-5pm.

Participation details:

On Saturday, July 10th, artists are asked to arrive between 10:00am and Noon at Kenosha's Union Park, (46th Street & 7th Avenue,) which is one block East of the gallery. That day, up to 40 artists will each create a painting or drawing for Lemon Street. We will provide your choice of a 24" x 36" stretched, primed canvas or cradled board, or a 22" x 30" sheet of watercolor paper. Please bring your own paints, brushes, and other materials you will need to complete your art-piece. Lemon Street will provide both healthy and less-than-wholesome snacks, meals and beverages, as well as live, acoustic music in a variety of genre. We ask that everyone complete his or her art-piece by 5:00pm that evening.

In the past, we auctioned off this artwork the same day. This year we've changed things up a bit! The artwork created on July 10th will be exhibited at various locations throughout Kenosha, along with information on the artist, and details of the upcoming voice auction that will be held at Kenosha HarborMarket on September 11, at 1:00pm. If a patron absolutely must own a piece immediately, there will be a "Buy it Now" option on July 10, allowing the person to pay a predetermined price to take the piece home that day. All proceeds from the sale of the artwork will be donated to Lemon Street Gallery.

We encourage you to invite your family and friends to enjoy themselves in "our" lovely Union Park. What better way to enjoy a summer day than outdoors with fellow artists? We are working on ideas for additional activities during CAGED! like an Arts Market, a neighborhood scavenger hunt for adults and creative activities for the youngsters! We are even exploring the possibility of publishing a yearbook, to be available at the September auction.

Lemon Street Gallery & ArtSpace, Inc. is a non-profit visual arts center in its 11th year. We are dedicated to the development of sustainable arts initiatives as they pertain to community arts education and economic development.
