Important dates you need to know

Please pay your dues on time!

- Dec 26 – Dec 30** **Artistree pick-up (if you participated) and drop off Warehouse Sale stuff** – The Warehouse Sale is a great way to clean out your studio of oldies but goodies, or art that you just want to go live somewhere else. If you wish to participate, **artwork must be reduced a minimum of 40% off your regular prices.** Attach a price tag to the FRONT of your wall-hung work with your name, medium, price. DO NOT attach one of the long inventory labels. Unsold works will go home at the close of the show.
- January 13** **Warehouse Sale Reception** **Second Saturday January 13, 6pm-9pm.** Please bring a snack to share. Exhibit runs January 3- 28th, 2018.
- Jan 28 (Changeover)** **1st Quarter Exhibit** (Jan 3- Apr 29th) Bring new art, please pay **1st Quarter or Annual Dues** by this time.

- February 18** **Annual Meeting** Hear a recap of the year at Lemon Street Gallery with the 2017 annual report. Meet, greet and vote for a slate of board members, artist-members and a guest are invited to attend. **Details to be announced.**
- Apr 29 (Changeover)** **2nd Quarter Exhibit** Bring new art, **pay 2nd Quarter dues.** Exhibit runs May 2 -July 29
- April 27-29** **gET bEHIND tHE aRTS Studio Tour.** The artists of Racine and Kenosha will be opening their studios to the public. Lemon Street will offer demonstrations. Consider doing a demo on Sunday (April 29th) for the folks that stop in! A preview party will be on Friday (April 27th – location to be announced) **Remember this also changeover weekend so plan your time accordingly.**
- July 29 (Changeover)** **3rd Quarter Exhibit:** Bring new art, **pay 2nd Quarter dues.** Exhibit runs Aug 1- Oct 28th
- Sept 16th** **PICNIC!!** Let's get together and play in Union Park. Time TBD
- Oct 28 (Changeover)** **4th Quarter Exhibit** Bring new art, **pay 4th Quarter dues.** Exhibit runs Oct 31- Jan 27th
- Nov 23 – Dec 24** **Artistree - Holiday Show & Sale** Annual sale of artist-made, giftable treasures. Reception: December 8th, 6pm-9pm
- Dec 26 - 31** **Artistree pick-up**
- January 27, 2019** **1st Quarter Exhibit:** Bring new art- Exhibit runs Jan 30st -April 28th 2019; please pay 1st Quarter or Annual Dues by this time.

VOLUNTEERS!

There are many opportunities to help throughout the year for your 10 hours of volunteer time:

- We need help with hanging gallery exhibits 4 times a year. This occurs on the Monday and Tuesday immediately following **changeover**. 2D and 3D setup is required.
- We need your help on **Second Saturdays** to click attendance, greet the patrons and talk to first time visitors about the gallery. Although it is a great time to chat with colleagues, it is equally important to talk with the public – you guys are the best people to talk about your work!
- We could use your help in **submitting events with online media outlets**. You can do this from home – just requires some computer skills – I'll show you how easy it can be.
- The gallery always can use a little polish! Bathroom **cleaning** days are Wednesday and Saturday – it's a big help to have you sweep or dust.
- We could use your help with **Annual Meeting AND Summer Picnic planning**. Help us find a location for 100 folks and help organize the meeting setup.

Other important things you need to know...

Your full name, the title, media, and price MUST be attached to all of your artwork. You can use a removable label attached to the wire if you do not want this information on your work permanently. Gallery tags are made directly from your inventory sheet, so write the information neatly and completely. Wall-hung artwork must be wired, no saw-tooth hangers or any other type of hanging device. Artwork is insured in all official gallery locations **ONLY** if it is on an inventory sheet. We only exhibit original work, not reproductions.

LSG provides artists personalized inventory labels for all wall-hung artwork. These numbers allow us to keep track of work that may be exhibited outside the gallery. In general, this means that all wall-hung work needs an inventory label.

KenoshaUnionParkProject (KUPP) is a neighborhood development initiative organized by Lemon Street Gallery in 2008. The goal is to encourage artists and their families to establish a diverse, cohesive, safe neighborhood that supports its residents in creative endeavors and small businesses.
