Screen Printing

July 24-26 (Wed, Thur. Friday) 6-9PM

Learn how to make screen prints from a digital image with the use of photo emulsion in this **3-day** class. In this class you will learn how to coat a screen, develop it, and how to do a single-color print! Supply fee will cover ink and emulsion. Instructor: Shelby Nesmith Class Fee: \$75.00 . Supply fee \$20.

Ceramic Screen Printing (3-week Session)

Bound Together: Photo Album

Come along with us as we demonstrate how to make a softcover photo album using the Japanese Stab binding method. Please bring your choice of writing paper, cardstock, and photos to put in the album. This hands-on class introduces students to copper-foil method (Tiffany style) stained glass craft by completing a small project. You will design a small sun-catcher, select and cut the glass, grind each piece, foil them and then solder the glass pieces together.

The second session students will learn to trim the vessel made in the first class.
